Anyone interested becoming CPR certified is welcome to attend the class. Certified American Red Cross instructors will be teaching the class. CPR certifications are valid for two years. All babysitters should consider being certified, as well as, first responders and medical professionals.

The class is \$50 for each participant; \$40 pays for the instructors and \$10 is for your CPR card. A light lunch will be provided. Preregistration is required by Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Checks can be made out to KFD or 'Zelle\*.
